Pension Conferees Recess Without Reaching Agreement

Congressional pension conferees broke for the July 4th recess without reaching agreement on several provisions of the Senate and House versions of H.R. 2830. Buck understands that "tentative agreements" have been reached on some key issues, but nothing official has been released.

Congress will return the week of July 10 and the conferees will then continue their deliberations. If and when an agreement is reached, a bill will be drafted and presented to both houses of Congress for a final vote.
